

# Recently Released Highlights — CTE-Postsecondary-Updates


- Completed October 2018

## Coming Soon Highlights – BAA Secure Site Functionality




- Same functionality that is currently in Secure Site will be on MI School Data.

  - Securely communicate with OEAA on issues found with data.




### Coming Soon Highlights – Parent Dashboard: New Data and Functionality


